Free-man vs. Sherill. Is the title of a case tried to-day before Justice Sumner, and involves matters of great interest.

After a full discussion of the case, the Justice decided in favor of the plaintiff, holding that stock cannot be lawfully impounded, even in a stock law territory, unless the same is surrounded by a lawful fence.

This seems to us only a just decision, and yet the effect, if tested, would be to effectually multiply the stock law in many parts of this county. We hope, therefore, it will not be tested until the county fences are made according to law.
