POLITICS IN FRANCE.
Politics in France are as much of a farce and a nuisance, even if not a nonentity so far as any good is concerned, as they are in our own country and time. The French people are by nature impulsive, fanciful and much given to pomp and show. These characteristics are as noticeable in matters of state as in social relations. The term "unhappy France" as applied to its politics and statesmanship is proverbial, and at the same time inapplicable. The recent failure of M. Melme, to form a cabinet when authorized to do so by his chief, is not a surprise to any one at all conversant with the present state of French politics. It was a failure through fear rather than for any want of ability. President Carnot is not President Grevy. He lacks his firmness, his foresight, his ability to cope with and master the whims of the French people. These were the essential qualities of ex-President Grevy's make up, they are entirely lacking in the character and administration of the present President of France. Hence, it is no wonder that M. Melme, hesitated and finally failed to call a cabinet. It would have been perchance but the cabinet of a day, a mere plaything, or caprice and liable to be blown away at any moment by the slightest breeze of discord. The same is likely to be the fate of the present cabinet, formed by M. de Freycinet and M. Tirard; but for the welfare and perpetuity of conservative, republican France, we trust not. General Boulanger is a typical Frenchman. He has won temporary victory and prominence by playing upon the fancies and humors of his people, rather than upon their good sense and judgment. He has the opportunity to make his success the success and welfare of all France. But will he do it? This is the question that is uppermost in every French heart to day.

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
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
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
