LONDON SUBURBS.

Handsome Country Places and Good Roads. One of the first things that arrests the attention of a foreigner when exploring suburban North London is the hedges. Running along each side of the roadway they rise four, five and six feet in height. They are in this district commonly of boxwood, and are kept perpetually trimmed by their owners, presenting a refreshing, continuous fence of this sweet flowering shrub for miles and miles. Some times there is a break in this green hedge. It usually occurs at some large estate whose owner, apparently jealous lest the public may see the treasures of his grounds and wither them by their gaze, puts up a seven-foot "hoarding" of "split-oak" wooden boards split from the half-log round. It makes a hideously ugly fence, a stone or brick wall would be no more expensive, and not so unightly, but the oak fence is the thing, and consequently the general rule of hedges and plantations is to be avoided.

The roads are generally unmacadamized and are always kept in excellent condition. They are raised in the center and slope toward the sides, where there are little "ditches" or channels to carry off the water. Except on the main roads, there is no attempt at "macadam" sidewalks. HYENAS OF THE DANUBE.

Plundering the Many Dead Bodies That Float Down the River. A painful sensation has been created here, says a Vienna correspondent of the London Telegraph, by an article in one of the Vienna daily papers, entitled "The Hyenas of the Danube," in which a grossly realistic description is given of the annual appearance of hundreds of corpses floating down the river between Vienna and Hungary, which are regularly plundered by the people on the banks, and then cynically thrown back into the swift current of the stream, never to be heard of again. The writer considers this horrible state of things mainly in a judicial light, and complains of the serious losses thus inflicted upon the living in consequence of the absence of all clue to the fate of their unfortunate relatives. "Year after year," he affirms, "hundreds of lifeless bodies—the mortal remains of suicides, victims of crime and victims of accidents—rise to the surface of the Danube, are swept along with the current, and washed up on the land on one bank or the other. Here they are discovered by the 'hyenas,' who rifle the corpses, and then, as a rule, kick them back on the waves, after which no human being worries about them more. Thousands of people vanish from the scene in this manner, no one ever learning what fate befell them. Blood-curdling crimes remain undiscovered, and the uncertainty whether a man is dead or will return again to his family and friends is often fraught with heavy losses to the latter. No mounds mark the spot where these unfortunate people rest; they are struck out of the 'roll-call' of humanity; no trace reveals the course of their last long journey; they have simply vanished from the world like the lost wanderer of the desert who is buried beneath enormous sand waves, or like the famished traveler in the wilderness whose body becomes the food of birds of prey. And yet we are living in Europe!"
