he could have secured the republican nomination on his record.

It was the power of support of the president that made the nomination of his party and the president seems to feel that the exigencies of the case require that the full support of the administration shall be given to Mr. Taft's candidacy.

Four Years in Congress.

"I have had hold office in a great extent four years in congress covers my official experience. I began life as a young lawyer practicing for a few years in Illinois and then went to Nebraska. I had no rich or powerful friends to aid me. Whatever distinction I have gained has been gained in the advocacy of the policies of government which I have deemed best for the people, and yet I think that you will agree with me that I have been reasonably successful. I was nominated for the presidency by a national convention of my party and received the votes of 6,500,000 of people. Notwithstanding my defeat, I was again nominated and again received about the same vote. After the lapse of eight years, I have been nominated a third time, the nomination coming from the rank and file of my party, and coming with a degree of unanimity that indicates that the principles which I have been advocating are acceptable to the party. His official record would not have secured him the nomination. I have been thrice nominated without an extended official record.

Is Consistent.

"He calls attention to things that I advocated but he does not give you a full list of them. I have advocated tariff reform for twenty-eight years and still do so. I have lived long enough to see the republican party frightened by the growth of tariff reform sentiment into making a promise of immediate revision, and Mr. Taft himself has been driven to confess that the present schedules are indefensible. I have advocated the income tax for something like eighteen years, and have lived to see Mr. Taft finally advocate it. I have advocated the election of senators by direct vote of the people for eighteen years, and rejoice to welcome Mr. Taft to its advocacy, although he only expresses a personal inclination toward it. I have advocated the ultimate independence of the Philippines and I have been rejoiced to find that in this campaign he admits there is no other settlement of the question.

"He says that I favored the free coinage of silver. It is true. He might also have told you that Mr. McKinley voted for free coinage of silver in 1878 that the republican national convention in 1896 pledged itself to international bi-metallicism, and that Mr. McKinley's first important act after taking the oath of office was to send a commission to Europe to ask other nations to join us in restoring bi-metallicism."

The majority of the victims suffered sprained ankles, cuts and bruises. Mrs. Ida Meadows of Johnson City, Tenn., was badly cut on the face and head and her body severely bruised. S. M. Dickerson of Roanoke suffered a compound fracture of the right leg. Mrs. John Beard of Roanoke had both ankles broken. The injured were removed to hospitals. Twenty thousand spectators were on the ground at the time and great excitement prevailed.

'LIBERAL PARTY' SPRUNG IN GEORGIA

ATLANTA, Ga., Sept. 24.—Politics was given a new turn in this state today when a call was issued for the assembling of what is termed "The Liberal Party."

Delegates from all states in the Union are asked to assemble in Chattanooga October 8th, to nominate candidates for president and vice-president.

The call is signed by Sidney C. Tapp as chairman, and B. D. Woodhall as secretary, both men being Atlanta residents.

The announced purpose of the new party is "The separation of church and state," the "total elimination of the church from politics," and the enfranchisement of women as voters.

The interlocutory decree was granted on May 24th. The custody of the one child, William Henry Vanderbilt, now about six years of age, is given to the mother.

They were married on January 14, 1901. The decree says that Mr. Vanderbilt shall have the right to apply at any time to the court on five days' notice to the plaintiff for directions in respect to his right of access to the child.
