HUNDREDS DROWN AS TWO STEAMERS CRASH TOGETHER

Passengers Were Asleep In Their Cabins When One Boat Went Down

WOMEN AND CHILDREN PRINCIPAL VICTIMS

Many Men And Almost All of Steamer's Crew Made Good Their Escape

(By Associated Press.)

MONTREAL, Uruguay, August 24.—In a driving rainstorm about six o'clock this morning the Argentine excursion steamer Colombia, and the North German Lloyd steamer Schlesien, collided at the entrance of Montevideo harbor...

The Colombia carried about two hundred passengers and a crew of forty-eight men. Most of the passengers were asleep and panic followed the crash...

Going to Peto.—The Colombia was enroute from Buenos Ayres to a festival at Montevideo, and the disaster has caused the keenest emotion.

Most of the survivors of that vessel were taken from the mats, and many of them were injured. While great numbers of women and children were drowned, almost every one of the ship's complement were saved.

Search of bodies has been recovered, and are now lying at the custom house, but many of them have not been identified.

The storm still continues, crippling telegraphic and telephonic communication between Buenos Ayres and Montevideo. The Colombia was an old steamer of 1,200 tons engaged in the regular passenger service between this port and Buenos Ayres.
