Press Representatives Take Him at His Word And go Back to Offices

(By Associated Press.) ARDEN, N. Y., Aug. 30 .- Edward H. Harriman, urged by weary repres sentatives of the press who have camped about his mountain home since Wednesday last, came out today with a statement that he was all right. Though brief the statement is straightforward and explicit.

The measure was so characteristic of Mr. Harriman's affable attitude to newspaper representatives, an attitude which was marked when he underwent the strain of a fengthy interview on the day of his return, that most of the men who have been here during the scare over his illness returned to New York tonight, relying on his word.

Harriman's Statement. Mr. Harriman's statement is as fol-

W.H. "I am pursuing the course laid out before I went abroad and advised by the physicians, 1 intended taking a rest as sooh as my responsibilities would permit My treatment abroad reduced my strength and vitality and weakened my digestion. The most expert physicians in Munich advised me to have an examination by surgeons as a matter of pre-aution. This has been done very carefully by Doctors Brewer and Crile in conjunction with Dr. Walter James and Dr. Lyle, and the whole result is that they find nothing serious, and renew the advice previously obtained that I should have rest and not see many people at one time, and this I am trying to do.




