INSANE RICH FINDS JUSTICE'S SWORD **MAY BE ARRESTED**

Sentence of Miss Linton's Assaliant, Commuted to Farm Prison

HEALTH NOT FIT FOR CHAIN GANG SERVICE

Cuse Is One of Most Celebrated in Legal Annal of State of Georgia

(By Associated Press.)

ATLANTA, Aug. 31 Vielding to the pleading of his rich and influential friends, the prison commission today recommended that the sentence of W. H. Mitchell be commuted to a year at the state prison farm from that of twelve months upon the chaingang at hard later-

The Mitchell case is one of the most celebrated in Georgia. One day last fall, a Miss Linton, of Thomasville received a note telling her that her brother was in a serious condition and asking her to come to him with hearer. The bearer was ap parently an old negress. The young woman, who was of good family and of more than ordinary social standing, wealth and beauty, obeyed the summons. When upon a lumby road in a buggy, supposed negress dranged the young woman from the vehicle and attempted an assault. He Rite driven off by a passerby and Mis Linton swore that she recognized Mitchell in the disguised negrets. The horse and buggy used by the sullant, was one that Mitchell had hired from a local liveryman.

Girl Gougitt Pardon.

Mitchell was convicted and seu tenced to the chaingang for twelvmonths. The friends of Miss Lanton contended that the penalty was in adequate and when Mirchell's friends applied for a pardon, the young girl's friends rallied to oppose it. The prison commission heard the case for two days. Mitchell's friends argued that if he committed the crime, that every because he was wealthy, had social position, influence and a charming family. MONTEREY, Mexico: August 21-4 Contribut the number of bodies recovered from along the shores of the Santa Catarina river, victime of the flood tetal approximately a thousand. In Monterey nine hundred is the total while meagre reports from along the alles increase the number. However, but little is yet known as to the loss of life and damage outside of this city. That the entire number lost will ever be known is not probable as many bodies must be buried in the ands and mud-

Other Towns Destroyed.

Reports continue meagre from points down the valley, but it is known that the village of San Francisco was entirely destroyed, the town of San Juan badly damaged and the town of Camargo on the Rio Grande is reported to have been completely washed away.

A rider from the town of Cadercyta, this gtate, the birthplace of General Geronimo Trevino, stated to The Associated Frees correspondent that twenty bodies had been recovered at that place, that hundreds were seen floating by with the flood and that on his trip from Cadereyta to Monterey there was not a depression in the ground or an arroyo which did not contain from one to ten bodies left. there by the receding flood.

A complete list of the dead is absolutoly unobtainable, but no Americans or other foreigners were lost as none of them resided in the flooded district. The entire northern part of the state Nuevo León nded and towards Tampico in the state of Tamanlipus alarming reports have been received.
