**WOMAN'S LEAGUE SELLS LARGE BROADWAY LOT**

Corner Broadway and Woodfin Brought \$13,000—202 Names of Members Necessary for Deed.

Magistrate J. D. Derold has charge of the deed of the Asheville chapter of the American Woman's League, which deeds the lot on which the building for Poole Brothers, is being constructed at Broadway and Woodfin streets.

There had to be 202 names signed to this deed, all the members of the Asheville chapter having to sign it and Judge George W. Shuford has been given the power of attorney to sell the property for the league. It is understood that the lot was sold for \$13,000, and already 165 members of the league have signed the deed, and Magistrate Derold is anxious for the rest of the members to sign, as he wishes to finish with it before the last of this month. 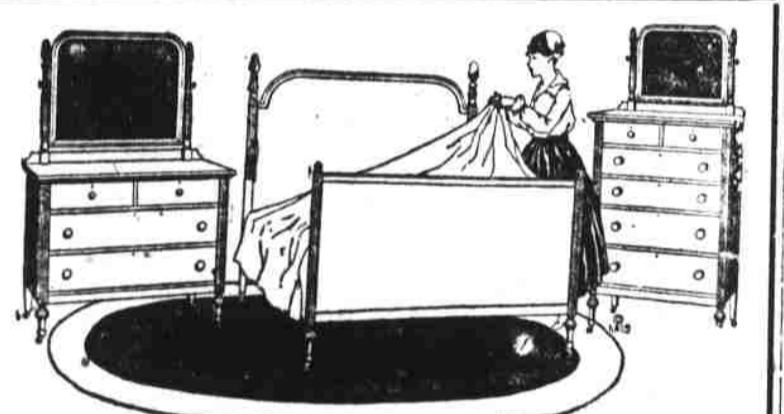
