Woolen Goods Designs Are Vivid And Large

pand to such proportions that their ground colors form the base or body of the cape, while the block itself appears as a border up and down the front, around the hem and across the bust and shoulders.—Dry Goeds White is to be the leading ground old or base in fine woolens for the

spring season.

The influence of white is in evidence in the grounds of fine Scotch woolens for skirts, capes, coats and outing suits. For example, white grounds are decorated with an endiess variety of colors in the form of stripes in sizes that exceed the width of the familiar flag stripes of "Old Glory."

Generally speaking the stripes comprise a medley of high sports colors and invariably each alternates with white, so that the general appearance is about 80 per cent of white with 20 colors.

white, so that the general appearance is about 80 per cent of white with 20 per cent apportioned to vivid colors. Nevertheless, block plaids carry the flag for striking effects, since white grounds measuring 4, 8, 10 or 12 inches square are bordered with blocks made up of high tones of the primary colors—blue, red and yellow—together with the secondaries—green, orange and violet.

Broken oblors, too, are chosen, such as amber, chartreuse, nasturtium pinks, yellow reds and so on. But in forming a mental picture of the color effects, do not forget that cally the high tones of the various colors are chosen, and that white alternates with each color so that the effect as a whole is white, lighted up with tints in variety.

Scarlet is one exception. Naturally this was chosen for a decorative coldr, since white and scarlet form one of the most striking contrasts known to colorists.

THE modern coffee pot, as part of the silver service, displays a familiar shape and form. But coffee pots were not ever thus. The earliest were of cylindrical form, with wooden handles-somewhat like the

kitchen coffee-pot. Later, they showed the characteristics of the contemporary tea pot, with shaped sides, like inverted pears, sharply receding to the pedestal. A more recent form resembled the late shaped tankards; and in the early nineteenth century occurred melon-shaped pots, which have survived in the modern crockery tea-pots.
