## RESTRAINT WRIT IS AWARDED IN VALENTINO CASE

### Screen Star Declares Treatment Under Contract Is Unjust.

NEW YORK, Sept. 30.—An injunction restraining Rudolph Valentino from appearing in any motion picture other than those produced by the Famous Players Lasky Corporation during the period of his contract was granted today by Supreme Court Justice Waserovogel. Pending final settlement of the case, the plaintiff corporation was directed to post \$25,000 as a security bond.

Valentino, according to the testimony, was engaged last January by the Famous Players Lasky Corporation at a salary of \$1,250 a week with the option of renewal at an increased salary for one year, for himself and another year, with other increase. First option was exercised, and then Valentino failed to appear at the studios at Hollywood, Sept. 14, thereby breaking his contract. The screen star's defense was that he had been unjustly treated, had been humiliated by his employers and at one time obliged to dress in the open while making a dress scene. He had, it was added, a very unhappy existence during the term of his first contract. His counsel claimed that under a ruling of the California courts Valentino's compensation was inadequate and therefore the contract was non-enforceable.

## Uncle Joe Cannon to Make Journey Homeward by Auto

### Recalls First Trip West From Tar Heels in Prairie Schooner.

WASHINGTON, Sept. 30.—Uncle Joe Cannon dug into the cedar chest today for some woolen things he will wear next week when he hits the same trail westward to Illinois that he and his parents broke 83 years ago in emigrating from the hills of North Carolina. The early voyage westward was made in an old prairie schooner, out of the back of which Uncle Joe, then barely four years old, watched the shifting scenery and dreamed. Even now, he remembers the nights he played around camp fire, the hardships and the stars that peeked down at him as he slept.

There was something that resembled a tear in the veteran's eyes as he recalled the early trip, but they sparkled as he talked of his coming trip over the same old pike—this time in an automobile.
