IMPORTANT WORK BY 'NON-COMS' IN ARMY

Flight of Senior Non-Commissioned Officers Calls for Action by Congress.

The National Defense Act of 1920 provided officers and non-commissioned officers, not on the basis of the authorized enlisted strength of the regular army, but on the basis of the obligations and requirements brought about by the new mission imposed upon this class of personnel by the exigencies of the World War.

After a careful study of this situation it has been found that about 1,800 of the senior non-commissioned officers of the army are to be demoted unless some increase in authorized numbers is made.

This demotion will carry with it such a loss of pay and prestige as to make it impossible for many of them to continue on the work now planned for them.

This situation is so serious not only on account of the work on which they are to be employed, but is such an injustice to the men themselves who as a class have long years of service to the country and are nearly all veterans.

The Secretary of War has asked Congress to amend the National Act and to authorize numbers in the higher grades so that the requirements for non-commissioned officers can be more nearly met.

Government Finally Secures Land Over Which Condemnation Proceedings Were Instituted.

The final step in the acquisition by the United States Government, of 158 acres of land near Azalea, as a portion of the Knottworth Hospital lands, was completed yesterday with the filing in the office of the Register of Deeds of a paper transferring title from The Azalea Company, owners, to the United States.

The land was condemned by the Government and the company filed suit in protest of the price set by the Government. As a result the land was valued at \$23,000 after hearing in court, and this is the amount of the transfer.
