BUNCOMBE GIVES WEAVER PLURALITY OF 4,020 SEMI-OFFICIALLY.

Representative Fabulon Weaver, Democrat, was returned to Congress by the voters of the Tenth North Carolina District, yesterday with a greatly increased Democratic majority totaling around 4,000 and swiping two heretofore Republican counties into the Democratic column.

According to official and semi-official returns from over the District received by The Citizen and by E. L. Laney, District Secretary of the Tenth District Congressional Committee, the majority for Weaver was as follows: McDowell, 600; Rutherford, 1,300; Henderson, 350; Buncombe, 4,020; Haywood, 2,500; Raleigh, 300; Swain, 350; Cherokee, 300; Graham, 200.

These figures give Weaver a majority of 11,200, which is the largest Democratic majority ever cast in the district, and receipt of these returns brought a demonstration from the Democrats.

Mr. Weaver's majority two years ago was a little over 2,800. When the voting this year was lighter than it was two years ago, it still can be seen that tremendous Democratic gains were registered throughout the district.

In Swain County Mr. Weaver cut down the Republican majority from 600 to 350 and lessened the regular 600 Republican majority in Cherokee by one-half. Graham last year voted Republican by 270 and yesterday's figures show that Weaver reduced this. Clay and Henderson were thrown definitely into the Democratic column. Definite figures from the counties today are not expected, but material to change these figures.

TAYLORSVILLE REPORTS DEMOCRATIC MAJORITY

TAYLORSVILLE, Nov. 7.—In complete returns received here tonight at 8:30 o'clock indicate a slight lead in a Democratic majority. Out of five precincts heard from the Democratic county ticket carried with a majority, except one which gave a Republican majority of 283. Reports received gave Republican ticket a majority of 27 in Taylorsville Township Nos. 1 and 2, as against 172 two years ago. Nothing definite has been reported in the Congressional race. Many precincts have not completed their count in the county ballots.
