OFFICER STRENGTH NEAR HALF COMPLETE

Captain Chipman, of 300th Cavalry, points to Opportunities for North Carolina Officers.

The 20th Cavalry Regiment of the 5th Brigade, 62d Division, which is a North Carolina unit of the Army, is now quartered in Asheville. Some 48 per cent of its strength consists of officers, according to a press release issued by Captain A. J. Chipman, Executive Officer.

In his letter, Chipman says that the 20th Cavalry is a "World War" Cavalry Regiment and the opportunity offered under the National Defense Act and in view of the fact that the majority of officers in the organized reserves is called particularly to the attention of North Carolinians, this regiment is a North Carolina unit of the Army.

An excellent opportunity is offered in the United States Army requiring no duty in times of peace. Having secured his commission he is assigned a command with a definite troop or headquarters and in the event of a declaration of war he simply takes for his commission becomes immediately active. This plan eliminates the dangers of the system resorted to in 1917.

A number of the Asheville men who were officers during the war have already been commissioned in the reserve corps and others have their commissions in the reserve pending.
