While he was opposed to construction of the dam, the mayor said that he believed fighting the proposition was useless.

W. E. Breese declared that he was unalterably opposed to construction by the government of any storage dam. He told of his visit together with Ralph Ramsey and A. H. Harris to the offices of the TVA and of their conference with Chief Engineer C. A. Bock. No definite information was obtained, Mr. Breese said, other than that the engineer said that a 200-foot dam was not being contemplated.

While no actual plans were dis-closed to the party of Transylvania men, the speaker pointed out that work had been stopped on the Boyls-ton Road, the Pisgah National For-est road and the state prison camp at Calvert, pointing out that this was evidence in his mind that the TVA informed the state highway officials to hold up such work pending further developments.

the enormous amount of materials. A study of the flow of the river, of the capacity of the reservoir and of cost estimates on each of the sites that appear most favorable, must be made. And finally, after the exact location is decided designers and draftsmen must make the actual working plans. More than a thousand drawings had to be made before work on the Norris Dam could start."

Regard the whole project as 'one huge dam,' if you wish to put it that way. No matter in which sec-tion of the valley the electricity is generated, it will be available to all sections. But each of these individual dams, under construction, or in contemplation, is needed to create this unified integrated system. The co-ordinated operation of storage reser-voirs as a unified system will also be used to secure a maximum degree

of flood control and improvement of navigation on the Tennessee.






