Three New Vehicles Being Bought <br> More than half of the students of Transylvania county, or 2,060 ride to and from school in buses, according to records from the county superintendent's office. The per- centage of bus students is $541 / 2$ of the entire enrollment. <br> During the past eight and onehalf months no days were lost due to weather and road conditions and not a single major injury occurred. <br> "It has been established definitely that riding a school bus in this county is safer than walking along the highway," Supt. J. B. Jones points out. Drivers are about half adults and half students, and the records for safety in this county are equally as good. <br> Mr . Jones states that on a statewide basis, however, student drivers have a somewhat better record than adults.
