Garrett Is Head Of Christ School Class

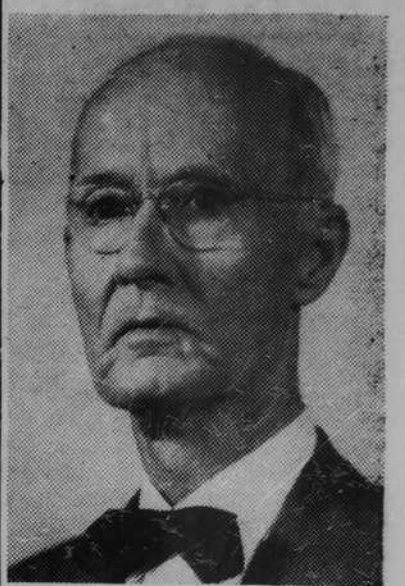
