Transportation to and from the site at Cove Creek in Pisgah National Forest is by chartered bus. Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, girls will be in camp from 9:30 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. On Thursday, girls will remain in camp until the close of the Campfire program that evening. All parents are invited to attend the Thursday night program from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. Brownies will plan to leave with their parents on Thursday and will not return on Friday. Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors and Day Camp staff will stay overnight Thursday, and leave by bus around noon on Friday.

The Low birthplace is filled with artifacts of the period as well as many of the personal possessions of Mrs. Low when she was a child.

All Scouts who tour the home are entitled to wear a special "pin," which shows a "Daisy" against the green of scouting. All interested persons are welcomed and especially Girl Scouts. If you are ever in the vicinity, do plan to see this. It is only about a 5-hour drive from Brevard!

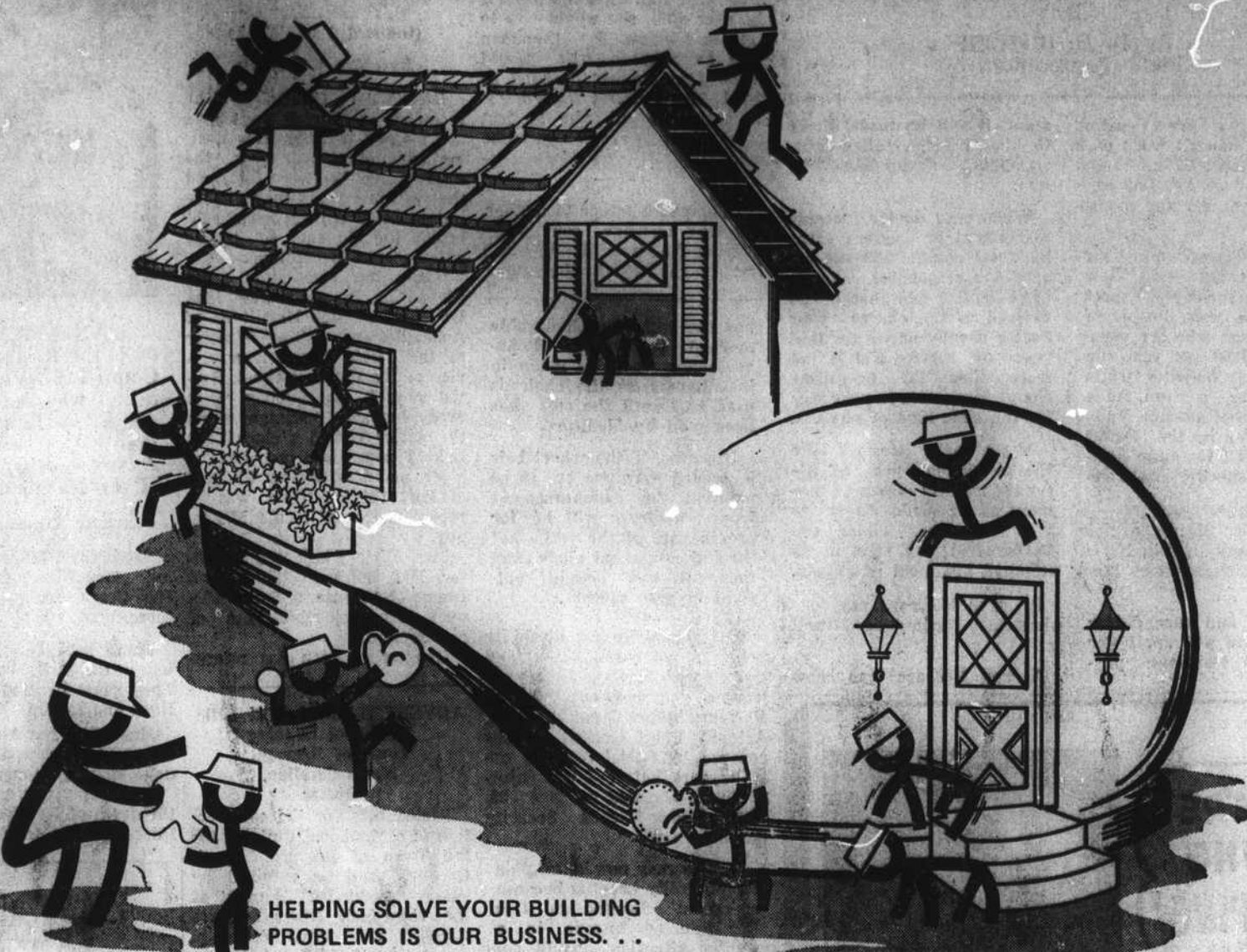
