Scholarship Program Established For Coordinated Child Care Program

The Transylvania County Coordinated Child Care Program was inaugurated April 26, 1970, under a 4C Policy Board composed of representatives from existing agencies interested in child development, parents and lay citizens; with the objective of organizing comprehensive coordinated quality child care throughout the county.

First Adventure Center, located in the First United Methodist Church facilities is the first step toward the overall goal. First Adventure Center is the first fully licensed all day center of its kind in the county. License requirements met include specific square feet areas for indoor and outdoor activities per child, fire and sanitary protection, daily health inspections, a hot noon meal and two snacks, afternoon nap period, parent-child communications, and a well-organized daily early childhood education program.

"The tuition per child is \$15.00 each week, and quite obviously, there are some applicants which are unable to meet this financial need. Yet these children should not be denied the advantages and training of First Adventure Center because of lacking funds," says the Reverend James A. Davis, Transylvania Council of Community Services.

"Therefore," goes on Rev. Davis, "we have established a scholarship program whereby interested individuals and agencies or clubs may contribute to scholarships for these children. We need help in this very significant and worthy undertaking for the children of our county.
