

Holiday Happiness - Holiday Unhappiness



For families and friends of people who have trouble during the holidays some thoughts to remember: When you are planning remember the difficulties which the person has. Whatever the problem don't expect that the person is going to behave differently than he or she usually does. Recognize, too, that they need your loving concern to help them through this difficult time.


