Transylvania Industries Awards Receive Annual Safets, Firm

The Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 has opened a "new era in safety," N. C. Commissioner of Labor Frank Crane told members of 156 Western North Carolina industries and firms last Friday night at the annual Safety Awards Banquet in the Greek Community center in Asheville.

The companies were given certificates honoring them for safety achievements made during 1970. Certificates were awarded to industries and firms which had no lost-time accidents for periods ranging from one to nine years.

Mr. Crane said until the law was passed, the N. C.

Department of Labor used the methods of cooperation and persuasion to help industries achieve high safety in their operations. Now, under the new law, the impetus will be on compliance, and the law will be enforced by fines and perhaps jail sentences.

He asked for the cooperation of all industries in complying with the law, and said the state's excellent safety record was the reason the U. S. Department of Labor, charged with enforcing the law, many permit the N. C. Department of Labor as the state agency to implement the provisions of the law.
