"Moonshine" Still Destroyed On West Fork Of French Broad

The Sheriff's Department destroyed a "moonshine" still on West Fork of the French Broad River in the remote gorge area last week, Sheriff Milford Hubbard reports.

There were no arrests.

Sheriff Hubbard said the still had not been in operation for about a month, but there were four barrels of

mash (some 250 gallons) ready to be run off when the still was discovered.

It was well concealed in the thick underbrush, and the Sheriff's Deputies had to hike for about an hour to reach the site.

It was a crudely constructed, galvanized steamer-type still, and dynamite was used to blow it up.
