Questions And Answers

Q. My husband and I both worked for many years. Now we are retired and get social security retirement benefits. He has recently been offered a job that will pay him \$3,000 a year. We heard that since we filed a joint tax return we can credit \$1,500 of his earnings to him and \$1,500 to me. That way neither of us would lose any social security checks during the year. Is this true?

A. No. Your husband's to-tal earnings will determine the amount of social security benefits he'll get during the year. However, your checks won't be affected by your husband's work if you are getting benefits based on your own work record. If you are getting wife's payments, your benefits as well as your husband's would be affected by his earnings.

Q. I am a single woman in my late thirties. As a result of an accident, I have been severely disabled since I was 10 and school and goes to work? have never worked under social security. A. Since you were disabled

able to work since that time, you might be eligible to get monthly survivors benefits. Call any social security office as soon as possible.

If your mother is living, she should also check at the social security office. She may be eligible for payments, too.

Q. I lost an arm while serving in Vietnam, but it has not kept me from working full time. I receive disability payments from the Veterans Administration. can I also collect social security disability bene-

A. No. You cannot receive social security disability benefits unless your impairment makes it impossible for you to engage in any substantial

Q. Is a 16-year old boy eligible to continue to receive his social security check from his deceased mother if he quits

A. Yes, if the boy does not earn more than \$1680 in a year. Whether he is in school or not has no effect as long as he is unmarried and does not earn over the exempt
