## Permits For Plumbing Work Are Required In Transylvania

The North Carolina Plumbing Code is in effect throughout Transylvania County, and it is a requirement that every plumber, or individual, secure a written permit from the Plumbing Inspector before the installation of plumbing systems or the extensions, alteration or general repair thereof.

After securing the permit and after work has begun, a rough-in test, must be made by the Plumbing Inspector and also a final inspection after completion according to the code. A certificate of approval will then be issued to the person to whom the permit was granted.

Every plumber and also

individual doing their own work must secure this permit and have work inspected. There is a penalty for violation of this code.

S. L. Capell is the Plumbing Inspector for Transylvania County and permits must be obtained from him at this home on Neil Road, Pisgah Forest, or Telephone 883-3070, or the County Accountant's office in the Courthouse Building, phone 883-2225.

President Dean McIntire presided.

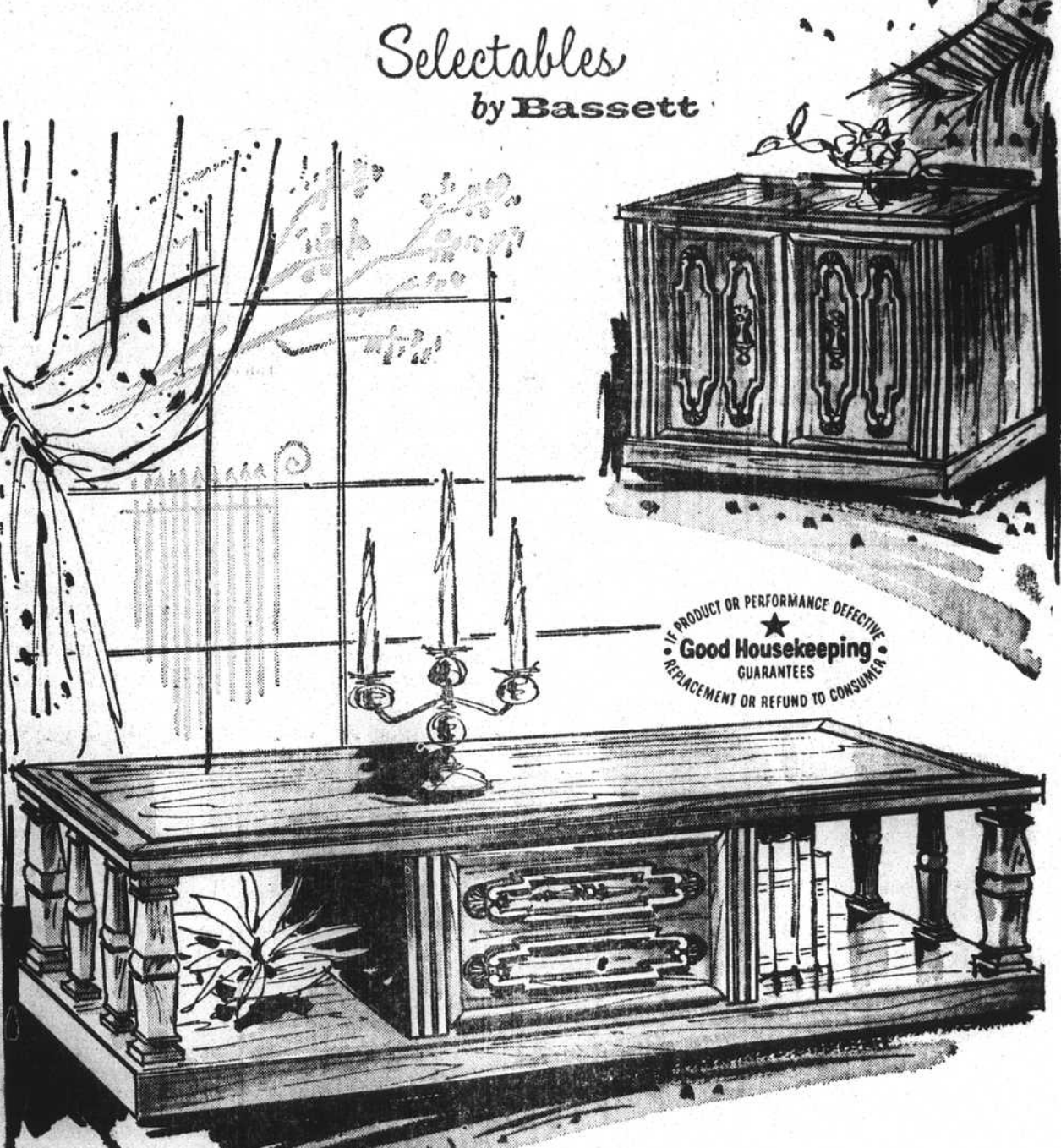
Ten members along with six guests were present. Two new members were admitted to the club.
