> A. Yes. You may start and stop your checks as often as necessary. And, depending on how much you earn when you do go back to work, you may be able to get checks for some months. Regardless of how much you earn you can get a check for any month you don't earn over \$140. Remember, too, that when you reach 72, you can get your check every month no matter how much you earn.

Q. I am 64 years old. Q. I am 66 and out of work curity card. Does he have to be a certain age?

A. No. There is no minimum age for getting a social security card.

Q. I am 68 and collect monthly social security retirement benefits. But I also work parttime during the year. How often should I ask the social security office to refigure my benefits based on additional earnings to see if I am due an increase in my check?

A. You do not have to request the social security office to refigure your social security benefits. This is done automatically each year.
