The entire month of October will be observed with special services and activities according to the announcement just released. The first Sunday in October, observed internationally as World Communion Sunday, will have special significance, with every resident member urged to be present and participate in this meaningful sacrament of the Church.

Then on Tuesday night, October 5th, there will be a fellowship meal, featuring a covered dish menu, to which all of the families of the Parish are invited. This gathering is sponsored jointly by the three auxiliaries of Good Shepherd, the Lutheran Church Women; Lutheran Church Men, and the Luther League. The climax is expected to be reached on October 31st, which is recognized as Reformation Sunday throughout the entire world.
