Adm. Ard says the members of the Board will assist students in anyway they can, and he plans seminars, etc., at the high

school. Various committees have been formed at the high school to inform the students of their rights and responsibilities now granted in a ruling by the United States Supreme Court.

The Court has ruled that all states must allow persons 18 to 20 years old to register and vote in ; 11 local, state, and national c. tions. Since the ruling went into effect on Jan. 1 of this year, approximately only 25 young people have registered in Transylvania.

Qualifications for voting in North Carolina include that the person must be a citizen of the U.S. and a resident of this state for at least, one year and of his voting precinct for 30 days Each registrant is required to present his birth certificate, driver's license, or

his date of birth. To be eligible to vote in the

May 5 election of next year in Transylvania County, a person must have registered by April 14, three weeks prior to the election. However, no person shall be allowed to register who has not yet reached his 18th

> Students shall not be registered where they are temporarily residing while attending business school, trade school, college, or university. They are eligible to vote in the county or state of their legal residence if they apply for an absentee ballot. This may be done by requesting an application form from the **County Board of Elections in** the county of their residence. This must be done no more than 45 days and no less than 5 days prior to any general election

To register in Transylvania County, a person must present Elections in the Courthouse. Upon showing proof of his age, he may register any of four ways according to his political other proof which i dicates affiliations. These include the

Democratic, Republican, and American Parties, or he may register as an Independent. The Board of Elections office is open Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9:00 to 5:00.




