

Over a million and a quarter teenage boys and girls are finding that an excellent place to get buying know-how is by participating in the 4-H consumer education-home economics program, sponsored by Montgomery Ward, and supervised by the Cooperative Extension Serv-

The program encompasses all phases of consumer education in projects directly related to the home, such as clothing, foods, home improvement and home management, family life and personal development.
