Jaycees Seeking Nominations For Local "Man Of The Year"

The Brevard Jaycees today formed a committee to seek nominations for Transylvania County's outstanding young man of the year, according to Stanley Tucker, President of the Brevard Jaycees.

The Distinguished Service Award, presented annually since 1947 by the Jaycees, is given to that young man in the community who is adjudged to have contributed most to the welfare of the community and who has given evidence of outstanding leadership ability and business or professional growth.

Mr. Tucker emphasized that the young man does not need to be a member of the Jaycees in order to be eligible for the award. He points out that the only limitations are that he be a resident of Transylvania County, be at least 21 years of age and not have reached the age of 36 before January 1, 1972.

"We are most anxious that the DSA winner be representative of the entire county and urge all persons desiring to nominate an individual to feel free to do so," says Mr. Tucker. Forms to be used in connection with the nomination are available at First Union National Bank, First Citizens Bank and Trust Company, Chamber of Commerce or may be obtained from any member of the DSA committee.

The winner will be honored at a banquet on January 21, 1972.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA 1971 SESSION RATIFIED BILL CHAPTER 932 SENATE BILL 120

AN ACT GRANTING PROPERTY TAX RELIEF TO CERTAIN AGED AND INDIGENT PERSONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 105-277.1 is hereby added to be entitled "Property classified for taxation at reduced valuation" and to read as follows:

"The following class of property is hereby designated a special class under authority of Article V, Section 3, of the North Carolina Constitution and shall not be assessed for taxation the first \$5,000.00 in appraised value of real property held and used as the principal place of residence of the owner and spouse if living; provided the owner is retired and the combined disposable income of the owner and his spouse, if living, is not more than \$3,500; provided further that in no event shall the disposable income of the owner or of any person contributing one-half or more of the owner's support exceed \$3,500. For the purpose of this section, the following definitions shall apply:

- (1) A person is retired when he is (i) sixty-five years of age or more, (ii) is not regularly engaged in income-producing activity
(2) Disposable income means gross income as defined in G.S. 105-141, increased by amounts excluded from gross income pursuant to G.S. 105-141(b) (1), (2), (4), (7), (8), (10), (12), (13) (14), (15), and (16).
(3) A person is an owner of property when he holds, individually or as a tenant by the entirety, the entire legal or equitable title, subject to easements, remov-

able liens and other similar encumbrances, if any.

(4) The principal place of residence of a person is the place at which he resides for six months or more out of the year.

The exclusion offered by this paragraph may be claimed by any person entitled thereto at the time he lists his property for taxation, and shall be supported by proof of disposable income in the preceding calendar year filed with the tax supervisor of the county or counties in which the property lies not later than April 15. Claim of the exemption and proof of eligibility must be made for each year within the time prescribed herein."

Sec. 2 All laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this act are repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect on January 1, 1972. In this general Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 19th day of July, 1971.

APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION UNDER G.S. 105-277.1

G.S. 105-277.1 provides for exemption from property taxation the first \$5,000 of the appraised value of real property owned and used as the principal place of residence by certain retired persons.

Claim for the exemption must be filed each year at the time the applicant lists his property for taxation. Applications for exemption must be supported by satisfactory evidence of the applicant's eligibility. Proof of disposable income must be furnished not later than April 15. These forms may be picked up from the tax listers in each Township and the Tax Supervisors Office in the Transylvania County Court House in Brevard.
