Transylvanians Can Now Earn Presidential Sport Awards

Adult 18 or older in Transylvania County can now earn Presidential Sports Awards which is similar to the President's Physical Fitness Award for youth.

The award can be earned in 31 different sports. Standards have been established which are designed to assure regularity of participation and an investment of time and effort conducive to physical fitness for those eighteen and over.

Some of the 31 sports are: Archery, Badminton, Bowling, Golf, Handball, Jogging, Skiing, Softball, Tennis and Volleyball.

An example of the standards follows for golf:

- (1) Play a minimum of 30 rounds of golf (18 holes)
- (2) No more than one 18-hole round a day may be credited to total
- (3) No motorized carts may
