Coach Norman Witek of

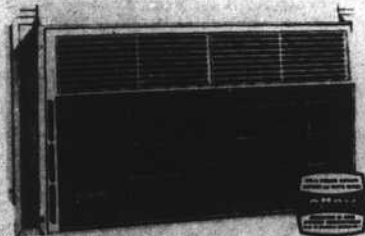
Brevard College and Roy Benson of the University of Florida will also be present for lectures.

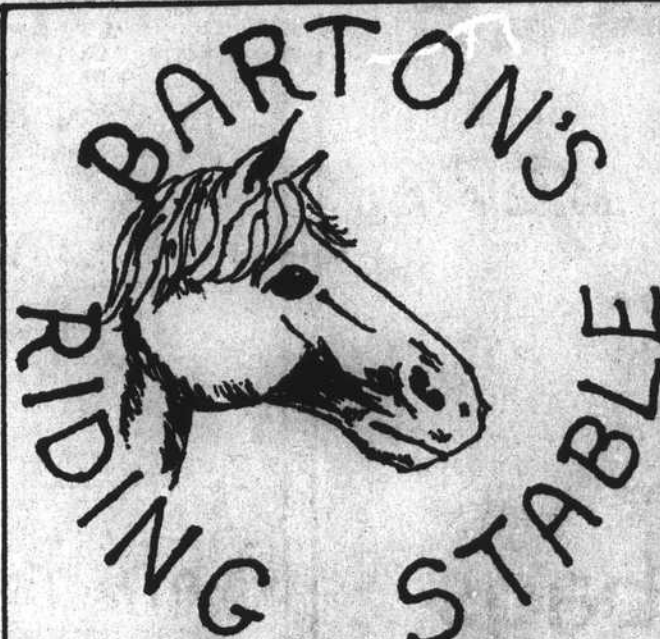
