> The district rangers are also recommending that chain saws be properly equipped with spark arresters to eliminate fire hazards and are limiting the type of fires built during wood cutting.

Mr. Kelley said the cutting of free firewood is being al-lowed in the four national forests of North Carolina, the Croatan on the costal plains, the Unwharrie in the pledmont and the Pisgah and Natahala in the mountains.

The cutting of firewood in the national forests will be mainly of dead timber and must be for personal use.
