Free Firewood Is Offered On Cut-It-Yourself Basis

NOTICE OF SALE
On Tuesday, January 15, 1974, at 11:00 o'clock A.M. at the Courthouse door in the Town of Brevard, Transylvania County, North Carolina, I will offer for sale at public outcry to the highest bidder for cash, the following described lands and premises, lying and being in Gloucester Township, Transylvania County, North Carolina, to-wit:

Commence at U. S. Permits to cut free firewood in national forests are now being issued for the duration of the energy crisis, according to Jack Kelley, assistant forest supervisor of the National Forests of North Carolina.

Mr. Kelley noted that this is the first time these permits have been granted regardless of where a person lives. Previously, only persons living within or adjacent to a national forest could get them.

"All we're asking is that people contact the district ranger in person at the district headquarters and adhere strictly to the specifications on the permit," Mr. Kelley said.

These permits may be obtained from any one of the 10 district ranger headquarters in the state. Nearest headquarters to Asheville Area residents are the Pisgah Ranger District at Pisgah Forest and the Toeocane Ranger District in Burnsville.

"The district ranger will determine where the wood is available in his district, explain the access and amount to be cut," Mr. Kelley said.

"We're stressing that fire-

wood should be cut only in the areas designated by the district rangers in order to limit the amount of possible damage to roads that have been stabilized and revegetated," he said.

The district rangers are also recommending that chain saws be properly equipped with spark arresters to eliminate fire hazards and are limiting the type of fires built during wood cutting.

Mr. Kelley said the cutting of free firewood is being allowed in the four national forests of North Carolina, the Croatan on the coastal plains, the Unwharrie in the piedmont and the Pisgah and Nantahala in the mountains.
