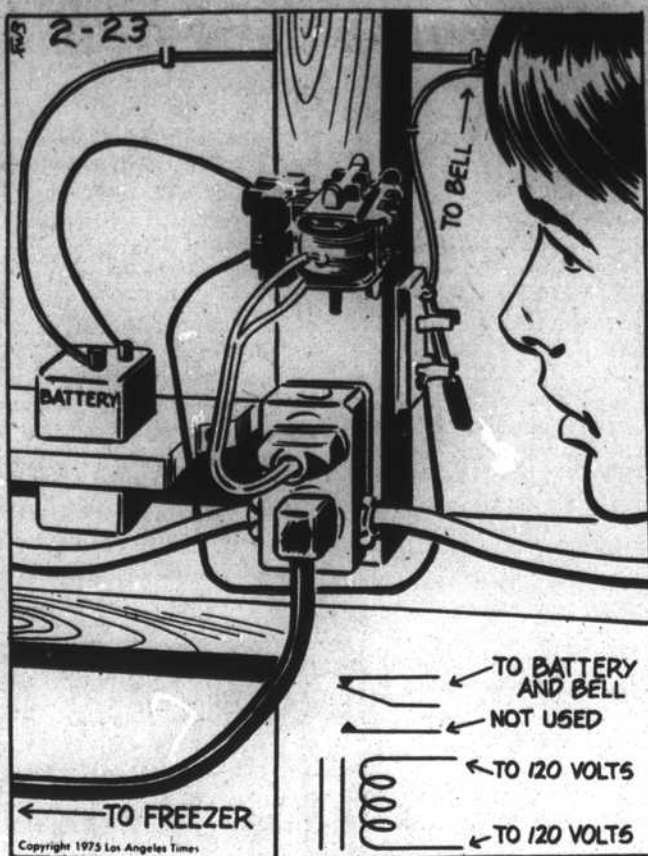

Science For You

PROBLEM: An alarm clock to wake you if the power goes off.

NEEDED: One relay, Porter & Brumfield GA11A, cord and plug, wire, bell, battery, switch.

DO THIS: Connect the parts as shown. Keep the plug in. If the power goes off, stopping the electric current flow, the bell rings.

HERE'S HOW: The electricity from the wall outlet keeps the relay energized. If the power fails the relay turns on the battery current to ring the bell.

If the GA11A relay is not found a substitute will do, but get an electronics man to help with the connections. Be sure the relay is in a metal box, since its bare 120-volt terminals are dangerous.

Such an alarm might prevent tardiness at school or might prevent spoilage of food in a freezer if the power is off long enough. The bell may be turned off by opening the switch, but it will stop of itself when the current is on again.

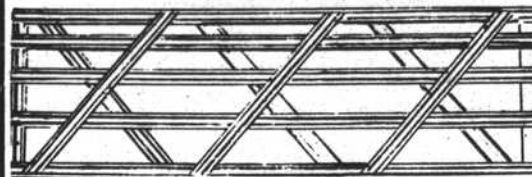

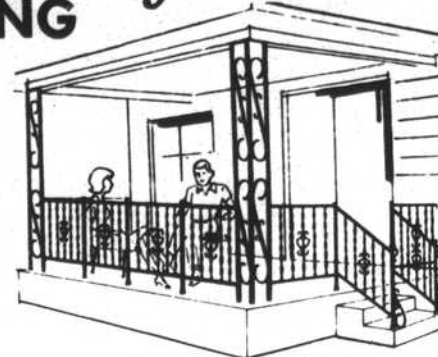
