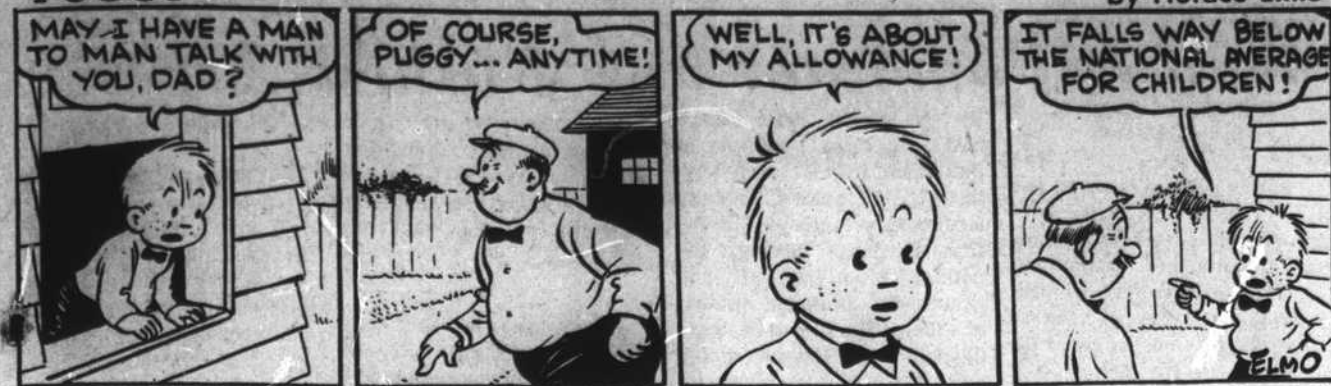

Lois Lambing plays Mama Kolowitz while Willie Klimek is Papa Kolowitz. The role of David's girl friend will be taken by Karen Southerland and John Holland will play Roger, Miss B's gentleman friend. Bill Moser will play the part of the lawyer.

"Enter Laughing" is based on the autobiographical reminiscences of Carl Reiner as a stage-struck boy from the Bronx during the depression.

We would like to extend our thanks to the employees at the NASA Tracking Station for their help in the cleaning up of 215, Thursday, Feb. 20.

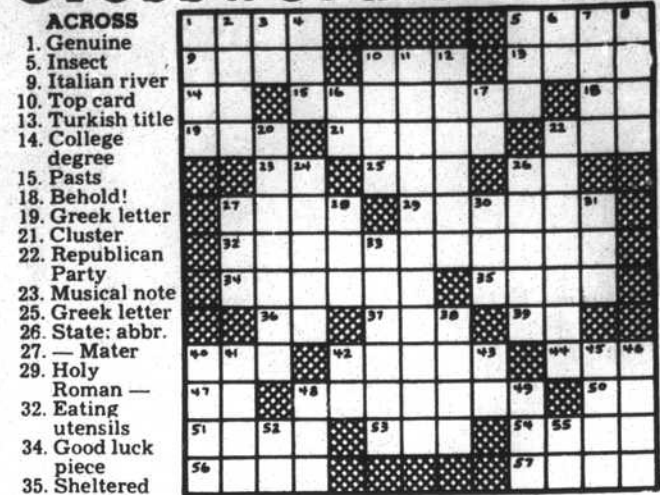
We would also like to thank the community is now selling dishcloths. The proceeds will go to improve the community. We need your support to grow and prosper.

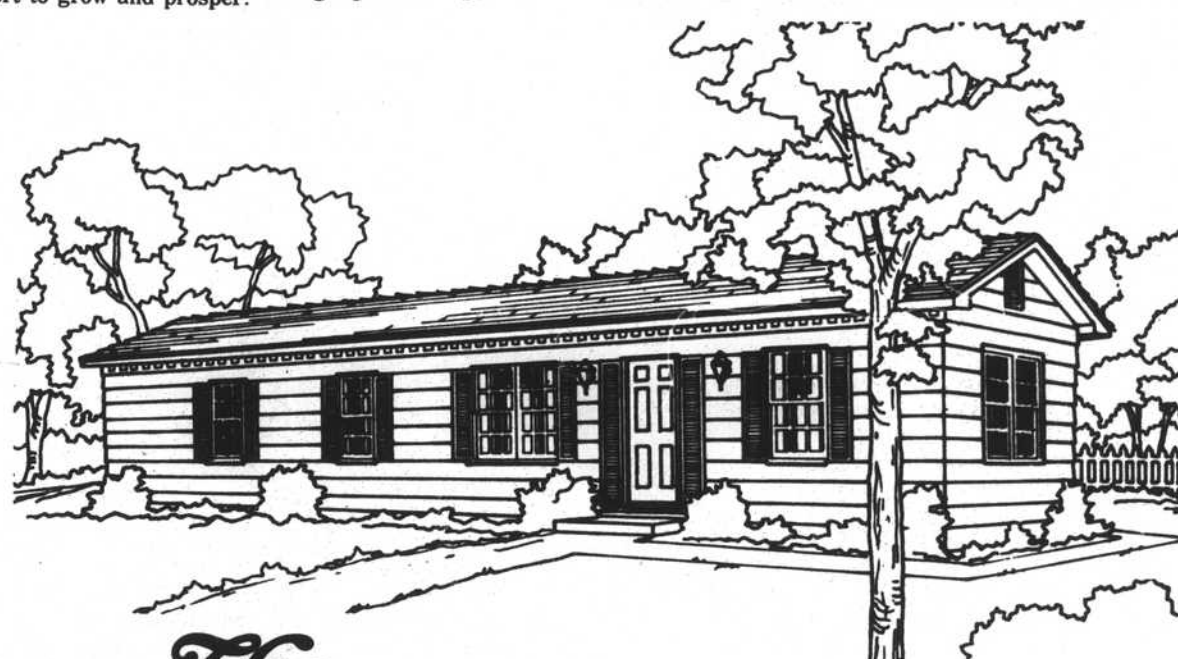

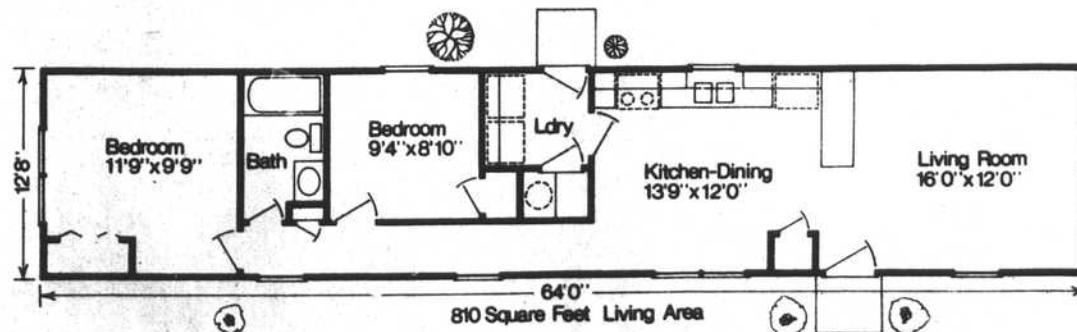
