DO THIS: Try to put the handle into the implement tightly notified that they must have by hitting the heavy head itself. Then try hitting the handle. The proper license under the state hammer tightens when the handle is hit in fine with its long axis.

> HERE'S WHY: The heavy iron has inertia - more inertia than the lighter wooden handle. As the handle is hit the energy of the blow is transmitted through it to the hammer, but the hammer's inertia prevents it from moving as quickly as the energy in the handle reaches it. So the handle is driven in.

> Inertia is the property of matter which manifests itself as a resistance to any change in the motion of a body (McGraw-Hill Encyclopedia). The inertia of a body is proportional to the mass of the body.

A simplified definition: If the body is still, it tends to remain still; if it is motion, it tends to remain in that motion. This is Newton's first law of motion.
