IN THE NEXT CONGRESS DEMOCRATIC BY 50,000

Democrats Gain Seven Senators Majority For State Ticket in That Neighborhood.

30 MAJORITY IN THE HOUSE

Republican Representation will be 164 or 165—Eight Seats Fewer Than the Democrats Now Have in 61st Congress—Elected Plenty of Governors.

Chicago.—Now 366 secondaries. Democrats elected 223. Republicans elected 163. Socialists elected 1. Fourth district 1. Total 393. Majority of House 196.

Democratic majority in House 29. Complete returns on the election of Representatives in Congress indicate that the Democrats will have a working majority of 29 in the next House. The number of Delegates elected to Congress according to the latest returns which are of an unofficial character is 293. The Republican representation will be 164 or 165 or 8 less than the Democrats now have in the State (61st Congress).

Latest calculations on the national ticket of Representatives based on complete but unofficial returns show that the Democrats will have a safe working majority of 40. The outcome of the United States Senate is now definitely settled. The Republicans are assured of 16 new senators while with 24 held over Senators gives them a total of forty.

These determined totals leave a Republican majority in the Senate as follows:

Four more sweep necessary to make it 46. Republicans 30. Democrats 4.

The states with Republican senators are:

California, Connecticut, Delaware, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Michigan, Nevada, North Dakota, S. D., Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Utah, Vermont, Washington, Wisconsin, and Wyoming.

The fifteen Democratic Senators assured are from Florida, Indiana, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Missouri, Mississippi, Nebraska, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia and West Virginia.

A summary of the contest for governorships shows the following Democratic governors elected with the approximate pluralities:

Democrats elected Governors in New York, New Jersey, Massachusetts, Ohio, West Virginia, Iowa, Oregon. In all these States there is now a Republican Governor.
