22 Soldiers Poisoned.

Houston, Texas, August 19.—Twenty two men of Camp E. first Illinois engineers, of Chicago, were taken suddenly ill with ptomaine poisoning Sunday afternoon at Camp Logan, and were at once removed to an infirmary. The company, in command of Captain F. C. Rossiter, 164 strong, arrived in Houston at six o'clock Sunday morning from Chicago.

According to members of the company, the illness is believed to have been caused by some sandwiches the men ate enroute to Houston. The sandwiches were purchased in Chicago.

More than 6,000 Germans have been made prisoners during the three days of fighting in the Verdun region.

Already the Italian offensive has resulted in the capture of more than 13,000 prisoners and 30 guns, and gains of great importance have been made all along the lines.

ALLIED CATHOLICS DOUBLE CENTRAL

New York, Aug. 18.—Pope Benedict's peace message to the belligerents lends interest to the fact that Catholics among the central powers are outnumbered almost two to one by persons of that name in allied nations.

Roughly, the central powers have 55,900,000 Catholics in the entire allies 100,000,000.

The pope is the spiritual leader of about 287,000,000 souls. Catholics living in the principal belligerent countries are divided about as follows:

United Kingdom	5,600,000
France	38,000,000
Germany	20,900,000
Austria-Hungary	35,900,000
Italy	32,500,000
Belgium	7,500,000
Russian Poland	12,000,000
Canada	3,000,000
United States	17,000,000
Total	171,500,000

From this total allowance must be made for the Catholic of over-run Poland and Belgium, who are not in a position to be belligerent.

This is certainly not a religious war. Not only do Catholics and Protestant fight on each side, but Germany's Mohammedan Turkish allies are opposed by millions those who pray looking toward Mecca owing political allegiance to Great Britain and Russia. India and the Caucasus and other southern portions of Russia have produced tens of thousands of brave fighters against Prussian autocracy.
