Given.

THE NEWS OF THE SOUTH

What is Taking Place in the South
and What Will Be Found in
Brief Paragraphs.

Domestic.

James H. Barnes, president of the lead grain corporation, New York, and Gen. F. Bell, general chairman of the mining division of the food administration, stated in the same city yesterday that they are awaiting a committee of experts to report on the possibility of a flour embargo in the eastern states.

A troupe train on the Pennsylvania railroad was shot upon near Blenner Juncture, Okla. Four soldiers were wounded, one seriously. The wounded and men remained on the train till it reached Pittsburgh. The train was held in formation as was done by the authorities as to the strength of the troops.

Samuel Gompers, president of the American Federation of Labor, and Mike Quin, spokesman of coal miners, announced their adherence to the cause of the miners.

Appreciation is made that the trial by court-martial of the participants in the New Mexico miners' strike will be delayed until next week, as the miners have agreed to give up their strike and return to work.

The Italians have at last secured positions which will enable them to completely dominate the German plan, but the positions were gained at enormous loss of life, and there will likely be a full in the fighting on that front for several days to enable both armies to hold their ground.

The Germans delivered an attack against the French on the Aisne field, but were repelled with heavy losses.

It is reported that the revolutionaries living in Russia are now after Kerensky, who is threatening the fact that those who do not support him will be exiled.

The news is that the central powers, to the number of 150,000, are preparing to make peace negotiations, promising the exchange of occupied territories, armistice, disarmament and all similar proposals, declarations are made relative to the measure of the central powers and their aims, descriptive of a peace which will insure happiness in all nations. This news is sent to the world through Amsterdam.

The same documents of allied governments have been advised that Sweden has decided to take steps to reform conditions in the foreign troops and that these will be furthered and extended to the central powers.

Washington.

The Netherlands minister to the United States, Mr. W. L. P. van Esch, has been received by the government. He called upon Secretary Taft to express his thanks for the kind reception given him in a dinner at the State Department.

Author of "Days of Revolution" has been appointed to a position in the Foreign Service. He is to be a member of the diplomatic corps.

The number of Americans in the United States, Canada and other countries by birth and those of those born abroad with Americans who have returned to the country, are given as exceeding 20,000,000, based upon figures of the United States census and from the house.

Deaths caused by the Typhus fever in the United States and other diseases of the same kind, are given as having increased with increasing severity, especially in the cities of Atlanta, Georgia, and in the state of Texas, according to the latest reports of the medical board of inquiry, which it is stated, is concerned in General Commission.

Supply Sergeant James M. Thomas, 22 years old, of Scranton, Pa., and Private Jessie Stockwell, of Atlanta, Ga., 24 years old, members of the Fifth U.S. coast guard artillery of the Chesapeake Bay district, stationed at Fort Monroe, Va., are dead at the result of drinking grain alcohol. The Army authorities are making a searching investigation of the case.

In a raid on the Philadelphia Telegraph, a long-established German language newspaper, which is charged with having been attacking government war critics for several months past, Federal agents arrested the editor and business manager and confiscated large quantities of correspondence, files and documents.

Equal suffrage for Negro women was defeated 160 to 140 at the special election, September 26, according to newspaper returns from two-thirds of the state.

Fifty-six alleged members of the Farmers and Laborers Protective association were placed on trial in federal court at Abilene, Texas, charged with activities in opposition to the selective draft law, which, in some instances, is alleged to have amounted to treason. The government will probably ask that the death penalty be imposed.

One Italian was killed and another fatally wounded when an attempt was made to break up a patriotic meeting in the Italian section of Milwaukee. Two police officers were slightly injured.

European.
A marked decrease in the destruction of British merchant vessels by mines or submarines is indicated in the *Weekly English Advocate*, a daily journal in London. Two vessels of more than sixteen hundred tons and six of less than sixteen hundred tons were sent to the bottom, against nearly twice that number the previous week.

Casualties in the British ranks reported for the week ending Sept. 11 show a total of 2622 officers and men, of whom nearly five thousand were slain.

The internal situation in Russia remains grave and chaotic, and just how it will be solved it is impossible to foretell. Apparently, the chaos of discord has so widened that either M. Kerensky, head of the provisional government, or General Korniloff, the deposed commander-in-chief of the army, who is opposing Kerensky and who demands dictatorial powers, will be engulfed.

Advices sent out from London say that the Baltic fleet is faithful to the Kerensky regime. Other advices say the commander of the southwestern army will support Korniloff.

Korniloff declares that his revolt against Kerensky is animated by the intense patriotism and desire to save Russia from a government dominated by the German general staff.

A Copenhagen dispatch recites that Germany will shortly be able to publish her peace terms. This statement is said to emanate from Dr. George Michaelis, the German chancellor.
