RELATIVES OF MRS. BINGHAM OPENED. Louisville, Ky.—The body of Mrs. Bingham, formerly Mrs. Henry M. Flagler, secretly was exhumed at Wilmington, N. C., Sept. 18, at the instance of Mrs. Bingham's relatives, an autopsy performed in the presence of a detective of national reputation and several physicians, some of whose organs removed and sent to New York and the body presumably interred, according to a statement by attorneys for Julius Bingham.
