**SENATOR TILLMAN SHOWS UP.**  
Surprises Association by His Vigor and His Optimistic.

Senator Benjamin F. Tillman surprised his friends last week by being present at the opening of congress. Considering reports of his illness, he was looking better than his associates expected to find him.

The senator says that he is feeling well and expects to take an active part in legislation. He is in an optimistic vein in regard to the outlook for the Democrats and seems to share in the feeling of confidence that pervades Democracy's ranks.

**Not Even for Cash at Christmas Will Girls Reveal Their Ages.**  
Boston, Dec. 9.—Not even for such allurements as a Christmas present of cash and promise of a pension, will the young women employed by the local telephone company reveal their ages. Recently the directors of the company voted to give the girl switchboard operators a cash present at Christmas, the amount varying according to age. It was announced that this Christmas gift would eventually develop into a pension.

One of the young men secretaries was given the task of tabulating the girls by age. He began his work among the 150 young women employed in the main office. After a few hours of fruitless questioning, he reported to the directors that the task was a hopeless one, as not one of the operators would answer his questions as to the date of her birth. The scheme has therefore been abandoned for the present.

**Hoke Smith to Help Simmons.**  
Governor Hoke Smith, of Georgia, who rode in his Maxwell automobile on the Glidden tour from New York to Jacksonville, has been awarded the \$1,000 loving cup by the chamber of commerce of Anderson, S. C., offered to the owner of the car making the best score on the trip. Governor Smith took part in this tour to make a study of public road improvement. He is expected to be an active and earnest lieutenant of Senator Simmons when he takes his seat in the Senate next month in working for the Simmons bill for national aid to States and counties in their road improvement work. Senator Simmons' argument that the general government should help to improve and keep up the roads its rural mail carriers use, is unanswerable.—Newton Enterprise.

**Memphis Man Has Beard Growing Inside of Mouth.**  
Memphis, Tenn., Dec. 9.—After having his chin hacked off and being saved by surgeons when they "grafted" a new one, made from flesh of his arm James Hart, the young farmer, at the Memphis city hospital, now faces a new problem or rather his chin faces one.

Instead of ingrowing toenails, it's an ingrowing beard that's causing trouble with Hart. When the operation was performed, the flap of flesh which covers the chin proper extending a little way underneath was cut so that it could be turned back and upward, the other surface on the inside of the new chin and lip. To this new raw surface grafted a square of flesh out of the arm, in order to do which the patient's right arm was bound over his face for two weeks that grafting might take place. Then the piece from his arm cut away. The two inner surfaces neatly grew together and the new lip presented a smooth outer appearance.

But there was a smooth surface on the inside of the mouth also and the hairs of Hart's beard began to sprout. They have grown thicker and faster and he is today, perhaps the only man in the world with a beard on the inside of his mouth.
