AS SEEN THROUGH EUROPEAN EYES

London, May 13.—"If it be true that Japan wishes to carry the California question to The Hague tribunal, we may shortly obtain a fruitful lesson in the practical limits of arbitration," says the Pall Mall Gazette today in discussing the situation which has arisen between the United States and Japan in regard to the California alien land-ownership bill.

The newspaper continues:

"If the Chinese and Japanese are to have free entry to the Pacific coast it means eventually the expiration of white labor from that region. All the arbitration in the world will not persuade the people of the western States that it is their duty to give up their bread and butter to an alien race and we can imagine how much likelihood there is of the Government at Washington taking measures to enforce such an award upon its own subjects. We would own subjects. We should rather like to see the experiment for its usefulness in bringing dreamers back to hard facts."
