If any pupil failed on work last year kins. and did not make it up at summer school, will be given a chance to take the examinations Friday afternoon at the grammar grade building.

You will note that the grades are divided into B and A sections. B section means that they are beginning that grade, A sections means that they are beginning the second half of the year. This is the work of the double promotion plan. The pupils in A Sections will graduate from High School at the middle of the year. Pupils in the B Sections will graduate in the spring. Forest City has the double promotion system thru the fourth grade now. It will take seven more years to have the system thru the high school. The reason why we are so far advanced as it is, is due to the fact that the first and second grades had enough failures who had completed about half of the work to begin them in A sections. Last year a beginner class was started in January and another class will begin this January. Many advantages are received from this system. If a pupil is sick and has to be out a half year, it is permitted to begin work where it quit school in place of taking the whole grade over again. This saves cost of instruction and the pupils time also. Greensboro, Charlotte and other schools graduate a class now in January.
