

Sale of Land For Taxes

WHEREAS, under the mandate of Chapter 213, Public Laws of 1927, as amended by the Legislature of 1929, the undersigned Sheriff and Tax Collector presented to the County Commissioners on the First Monday in August, 1930, a full report showing the uncollected taxes for the year 1929; and

WHEREAS, as required by said laws the County Commissioners have adopted the following order:

It appearing that the list hereunto attached was furnished us by the Sheriff of Rutherford county as a list of the delinquent and uncollected taxes due said county, it is therefore ordered that the lands and property, or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay said delinquent taxes, shall be advertised for sale in one of the newspapers published in Rutherford County for a period of four weeks prior to the First Monday in September, 1930, when the Sheriff of said county shall sell said property in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided.
