

THE WAKE FOREST SCHOOL FOR PREACHERS

Was held this year June 7-18, at Meredith College, Raleigh. It was changed from Wake Forest this year on account of a conflict in time with the Wake Forest Summer School. The new Meredith is an ideal location and the buildings are modern and up to date in every respect. President Brewer and his co-workers did everything possible for the convenience of those present and all were made happy.

More than 280 preachers and their wives attended this school. Quite a number dropped in for a day and were not registered. Practically every part of North Carolina was represented and several brethren from Virginia and some from South Carolina. The preachers present were representative of North Carolina Baptist pulpits from the first churches to the remote country churches.

The faculty was one of the best to be secured anywhere. Dr. B. W. Spillman of Winston opened the school with a message on "The Charm of Expository Preaching." Dr. A. T. Robertson of Louisville, Ky., one of the foremost New Testament Greek Scholars in the world today, spoke twice daily. In the morning his subject was, The Churches of the New Testament. In the evening he lectured on the Gospel of John. Dr. L. E. M. Freeman of Meredith College lectured on the book of "The Acts of the Apostles" each day. Dr. Lynch of Wake Forest College taught Homiletics or sermon building.

Dr. W. R. Cullom of Wake Forest College lectured on Pastoral Problems and the Pastor's Reading.

Dr. Hipps of China lectured on World Problems as Viewed from the standpoint of the Missionaries.

Dr. John Lowe of China gave some inspirational addresses on his work in China.

Dr. A. J. Smith, Pastor of the First Baptist Church of Goldsboro, led the vesper service each evening, using as his subject Christ the Soul Winner, based on the fourth chapter of John.

A course in Missions was given to the pastor's wives by Mrs. Philips of Nashville, N. C.

Prof. Lynch and wife, Buie's Creek, had charge of the music. He gave a brief lecture each day making suggestions to the Pastors as to how to improve their music.

Two of the outstanding features of the school were lectures on Evangelism by Rev. Herman T. Stevens of High Point, N. C., and formerly Supt. of Evangelism under the State Mission Board; and lectures on Church Efficiency by Dr. F. A. Agor of the Northern Baptist Convention and perhaps the best authority on this subject in America.

The fellowship of this school was well worth the entire cost which was only \$1.00 per day for board and lodging for each person.

This school is sponsored jointly by the State Mission Board and The Educational Board. It's value to N. C. Baptists can not be estimated. Every Baptist preacher in N. C. ought to plan to attend the Wake Forest School for Preachers next year. Dr. W. R. Cullom served as Dean and contributed much to the success of the school.

Halifax County Not Among Them

Under a head, "County Systems Irresponsible," there appeared a story in Sunday's News and Observer regarding the business management of the affairs of county governments within the State, but we want to emphatically state that Halifax County does not rank among the great majority which the writer picturizes.

Beginning with the Board of County Commissioners, which is the executive body of the County, it is composed of two presidents of the larger banks in the county, one large merchant and bank director, one dirt farmer and one large manufacturer; and as a body represents the very best interests of the county. It's Register of Deeds is a successful business man; it's Road Board is composed of the chairman, who is the business manager of a large manufacturing concern, and its other members are men successful in their particular line of business. The School Board is composed of a banker, a lawyer and a large farmer, and its Clerk of Court is recognized as one of the best in the State, as well as one ranking well as among those of the longest service. It has a Treasurer, who since his inception into office has made a financial report of the county's affairs each month to the Board of Commissioners as well as a financial statement to each particular board each month. It has a County Auditor, who consolidates the statements of the various officers and boards each month, a report being made on the 25th of each month, and such consolidated reports are laid before the Board of Commissioners each month. It has a Sheriff who is diligent in the enforcement of the law, and

who, thru his deputies in the various townships, collects the taxes of the County and reports monthly to the Treasurer.

It is true, that like a corporation, the County of Halifax has no directing head, yet its Board of Commissioners are at all times fully conversant with the affairs of each and every board and with the expenditures of each board. Once a year the commissioners meet with the school and road boards and make a budget for the year and levy the taxes to meet the requirements, and the treasurer requires each board to hold itself within its income.

There might be improvements but as to the character of the members of the various boards and that of the other officers who administer the affairs of the county, they represent the highest type of citizenship and are conscientious in exacting the most efficient and economical administration of public affairs. A recent audit has been made of all departments of the county and the most modern system of accounting has been installed. Other counties may be lacking in efficiency and failing in real public service, but Halifax County cannot be counted among them. —The Commonwealth.
