Master of Grange Likes Electricity Ballard S. Gay.

Permanent good is sure to come of the present co-operative investigations of the use of electricity on the farm, according to L. T. Taber, master of the National Grange. Mr. Taber, in an interview just published, says: per bottle.

"A generation ago it would have been supposed that electrical development and the use of electrical energy was of little concern to the farmer; that those in cities and towns were more vitally interested in this mighty and mysterious power than those who till the soil.

"The last decade has seen a transformation along the lines of the use hand in our warehouse in Conway of electricity in farm homes and farm work. The farm electrical plant has been most valuable. The farmer in many sections will be vitally concerned in the development of high tension power lines and proper transmission of electrical current for rural uses

"It is probable that we are yet in infancy in the use of electricity. This is obviously true as applied to agricul ture. Any organization that directs its attention toward a better under standing of the relation of electricity to rural life will perform an invalu able service."
