## DISASTROUS FIRE.

### THE BUSINESS PORTION OF BEAUFORT IN ASHES.

13 Stores and 9 Warehouses Succumb to the Fire. The Fire Originated in the Store of T. W. Moore, Jr., on the South side of Front Street, and to our town having no organized fire department it was a long time before some plan was adopted to stop the ravages of this destructive element. The major of our town, Mr. L. A. Skarson was promptly on hand, and ready to aid in any way that he could. He gave orders to tear the market house down, this was partially done, and the fire was stopped, after having destroyed 13 stores and 9 warehouses. Had the fire crossed the street opposite Davis & Bros. store, the town would have been doomed.

The stores on the north side of front street were all saved, by the use of tin garden pumps, which were handed out by Mr. D. Pierce. We have often remarked that the colored Citizens of Beaufort were the best in the world, they more than proved it on this occasion. We can not give an estimate as yet of the losses. Guthrie & Co., are the heaviest losers. The stores and Warehouses occupied by following merchants were completely destroyed: Guthrie & Co., T. W. Moore, Jr., Taylor & Buckman, C. A. Clawson, Dr. T. B. Delamar, Wm. Sabiston, J. W. Garbri, Chadwick & Jones, Fios. Thomas, W. F. Hill, Roberson & Bro., John E. Henry, and Ann Henry. What was needed on this occasion was an anti fire department. No fire should be lost, a town the size of Beaufort should have means to fight fire, shall we have it or not? Had there been some kind of an organization to fight fire we would not have had to record the loss of so much valuable property. Let the Business men of Beaufort organize a fire department at once.

The Christmas tree entertainment which was gotten up for the benefit of the children of Ann St. M. E. Church was a success. We were not present, but have been informed that those who contrived, felt more than repaid for their donations, by seeing the children so well pleased. Some old fogey will always enter his protest against such entertainments, he forgets that the child is a child, and delighted in such things. Let us have more of such entertainments that are not only entertaining but instructive. The scholars of St. Paul's P. E. Church were also given an entertainment and from the description of select literature with which they were furnished. Money and time expended in the Sunday School cause is "bread cast upon the waters." The Sunday Schools of a town need entering progressive men at their head. They should have choice libraries, cards, and an abundance of select literature with which to store the minds of the young. Sunday school treasures should not be expended to pay the running expenses of a church. Our space is limited but we need to say a few words to our friends. The Editors of the Record has fought hard to keep the weight from the doer's back. The change of this paper a trifle over one year ago. We cannot continue the publication of the paper another year unless we have a better advertising patronage. It would be a lasting disgrace upon the business men of this town if the publication of their town and county paper die for want of patronage. Agreeable to a custom, Rev. J. W. Jones, the beloved pastor of Ann Street M. E. Church, who has filled said pulpit for the past two years, goes to another field as a laborer in the Kingdom of Christ. During the period in which this estimable Christian gentleman has labored among us, he won the hearts of our people. He leaves behind a host of friends, who wish him God's speed in his new home, and to whom he has been a blessing. The Bishop has assigned to this station for the present year, Rev. F. A. Bishop. Our people welcome him with open hearts and hands. We trust that his stay among us will be productive of much good. The people have a part to perform as well as the preacher. We hope that the new pastor will devote as much of his time as possible in the Sunday School.

The old year with its joys, and sorrows is gone. If our time and talents have been wasted, it is late to repine—the year is gone and we cannot recall it. In looking back in review, if we can point to a good, noble action or recall some deed of charity, then the year was not spent in vain. If we cannot do this, then 1887, was a dismal failure and we should map out better plans for the new year. An estimable Christian lady of this town, who has recently gone to her reward, often said "that if a day passed that she did not do something for God, or for suffering humanity, she considered that day lost."
