The Election.

Next Tuesday and the great Jury of American Citizens will render a verdict settling the question as to who will control the National Government for the next four years. While it is impossible to say what will be the result, the tendency of political events seem to point to Judge Parker the Democratic nominee as the next President of the United States. Both sides however are claiming the election. The Democrats claim 220 Two hundred and Fifty-five electoral votes certain with a dozen or more doubtful. Two hundred and Thirty nine votes are sufficient to elect, so the Democrats claiming Judge Parker by Sixteen votes more than enough to insure his election. The Democrats claim Two hundred and Twenty five Democratic members of Congress out of 388. This will give the Democrats in the next House of Representatives in Congress a majority of Thirty one. So they will have the organization of the House. The Senate however will still remain Republican. The State is claimed Democratic by 51,000 to 75,000 majority, with a large majority of the Legislature Democratic. The Democratic County ticket will all be elected from 100 to 200 majority. At least this is the way it all looks just now.
