

HOW TO MAKE USE OF PITCH?

Question That is Puzzling Manufacturers Looking to Dispose of Accumulation of the Stuff.

Huge stocks of pitch accumulated at the gas works quarry during the war, and as they are constantly being added to their disposal has become a serious problem. Only by finding a new outlet can we hope to dispose of them, says a leading authority in a highly suggestive paper read before the British Coke Ovens association. He directs attention to the possibility of finding in pitch a very effective form of fuel, a demand for which it would not in these times of comparative scarcity of combustibles be difficult to create.

The enormous calorific value of pitch is but rarely recognized, perhaps on account of the extreme difficulty experienced in attempts to burn it under boilers. The author asks: Is it not possible to obtain a constant feed of liquid pitch, heated to fluidity by the radiant heat of a producer, which could be ejected on to the bed of fuel by means of the air and steam necessary for its consumption? A very much greater efficiency could be obtained by converting pitch into such gases and burning them under boilers and in oven-fines than by the direct burning of the pitch.
