Swiss Watch Industry.

In a survey of the Swiss trade in watches for last year, Trade Commissioner H. Lawrence Graves at Zurich points out that more and more the exports of these articles to the United States are being confined to finished watch movements without the case The value of finished movements, without cases and of watches complete with cases of gold, silver and nonprecious metals, including chronographs and all watches of funcy deeign, amounted to \$14,211,051. Of this total the entre of the finished movements, without cases, was \$8,-280,720. This last figure represents about 83 per cent of the total exports of finished movements from Switzerland during 1919, the rest going largely to England, Canada and Japan.
