Trains Nos. 17 and 18 will be discontinued between Belhaven and Washington. These trains will continue to operate between Washington and Raleigh, leaving Washington 8:15 A. M., arriving Raleigh 1:05 P. M. No change Raleigh to Washington.

Trains Nos. 53 and 54 between Belhaven and Washington will leave Belhaven 6:00 A. M. arriving Washington 8:00 A. M., leave Washington 10:00 A. M. arriving Belhaven 1:25 P. M.

Train No. 44 will leave Belhaven 9:30 A. M. arriving Macks 11:50 A. M. daily except Sunday.

Train No. 48 will leave Columbia 9:30 A. M. arriving Macks 11:50 A. M., except Sunday. No change in train 148.

Train Nos. 37 and 38 will be discontinued between Suffolk and Beckford Junction.

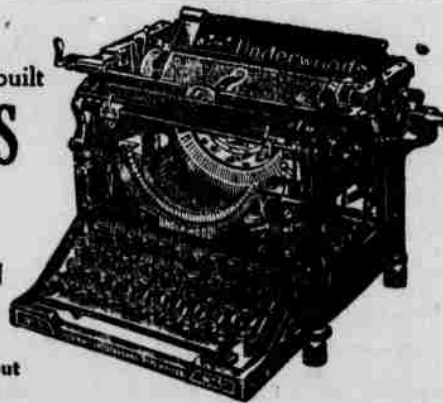
